II.B. Occupation status

Select one of the following

- Exx = Employed (indicate working time percentage: E50, E60, E80, E100, attach pay slips)
- I = independent professional activity / self-employed / own business
- H = stay at home parent
- N = unemployed (attach certificate ADEM)
- P = pensioner (attach pay slips)
- S = student in School
- U = student in University or other higher education
- T = Internship / vocational training

Indicate all applicable categories if a person combines two or more occupations simultaneously (e.g. I+H, U+E50) or has changed occupation recently (i.e. during the period, for which the income is declared)

II.C. Annual net income received from employer
